What is are STC's and how do they help save on solar?

So if you're looking to install solar and reduce your upfront costs, you'll want to understand how STCs work. At Aus Solar Kits (ASK), we make solar simple by supplying high-quality kits that qualify for these government incentives. Here's how it all works and how you can benefit.

STCs stand for Small-scale Technology Certificates.

They're part of a government incentive under the Renewable Energy Target (RET)

They are designed to encourage more Australians to switch to renewable energy.

When you install a solar system under 100kW, you're eligible to earn STCs.

The number you receive depends on:

- The size of your system
- Your location
- How much energy your system is expected to generate over time

Each STC represents 1 megawatt-hour (MWh) of expected clean energy.

These certificates can be traded for money, which helps bring down the cost of going solar.

How is works with Aus Solar Kits (ASK)

You purchase a solar kit from ASK

All of our kits are designed to be STC-eligible. That means they meet the right standards and can qualify for the government incentive.

2. You choose your own installer

3. Your installer handles the STC paperwork

In most cases, your installer will manage the STC claim for you. They'll usually offer to apply the value of your STCs as an upfront discount off your installation price. It saves you the hassle of dealing with the admin side of things.
